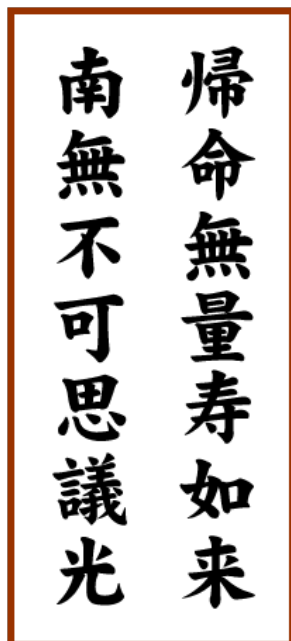


History, Liturgy, Teachings: Shinran Shonin's Shoshinge
